



Silent Auction Rules

By participating in the Cheam Cricket Club Silent Auction, each bidder agrees to the following auction rules:



1. Bids may be placed via the Cheam Cricket Club website up to midnight on Friday 28th October 2016.
2. No bids will be accepted after 12am Saturday 29th October 2016.
3. Once made, bids may not be retracted.
4. The winner of each lot will be the highest recorded bidder at midnight on Friday 28th October 2016.

5. **Reserve Price:** a reserve price exists for all lots at the start of the auction. To win an auction, bids at or above the reserve price must have been made by the auction close.
6. Cheam Cricket Club's Cricket Committee decision as to the winner of each lot is final.
7. All sales are final. There are no exchanges or refunds.
8. In the event of two or more highest bids being received for the same amount for the same bid item, the person who placed their bid first will win.
9. Payment should be made by cheque or electronic transfer.
10. Winning bidders should arrange collection with the Club of item(s) won. Payment may be deferred by a maximum of 7 days if means of payment is not available. In this event, a deposit of 20% of the sale price must be paid.
11. Any lot remaining unsold will be disposed of at the discretion of Cheam Cricket Club.
12. If a winning bidder fails to pay within 7 days of the close of the auction, the next highest bidder will win the item.
13. All items are "as is." The Cheam Cricket Club Cricket Committee has attempted to describe items correctly based on the information provided by donors.
14. Each person bidding assumes all responsibilities related to the auction and items obtained at the auction and agrees to hold Cheam Cricket Club Cricket Committee harmless from any liability.
